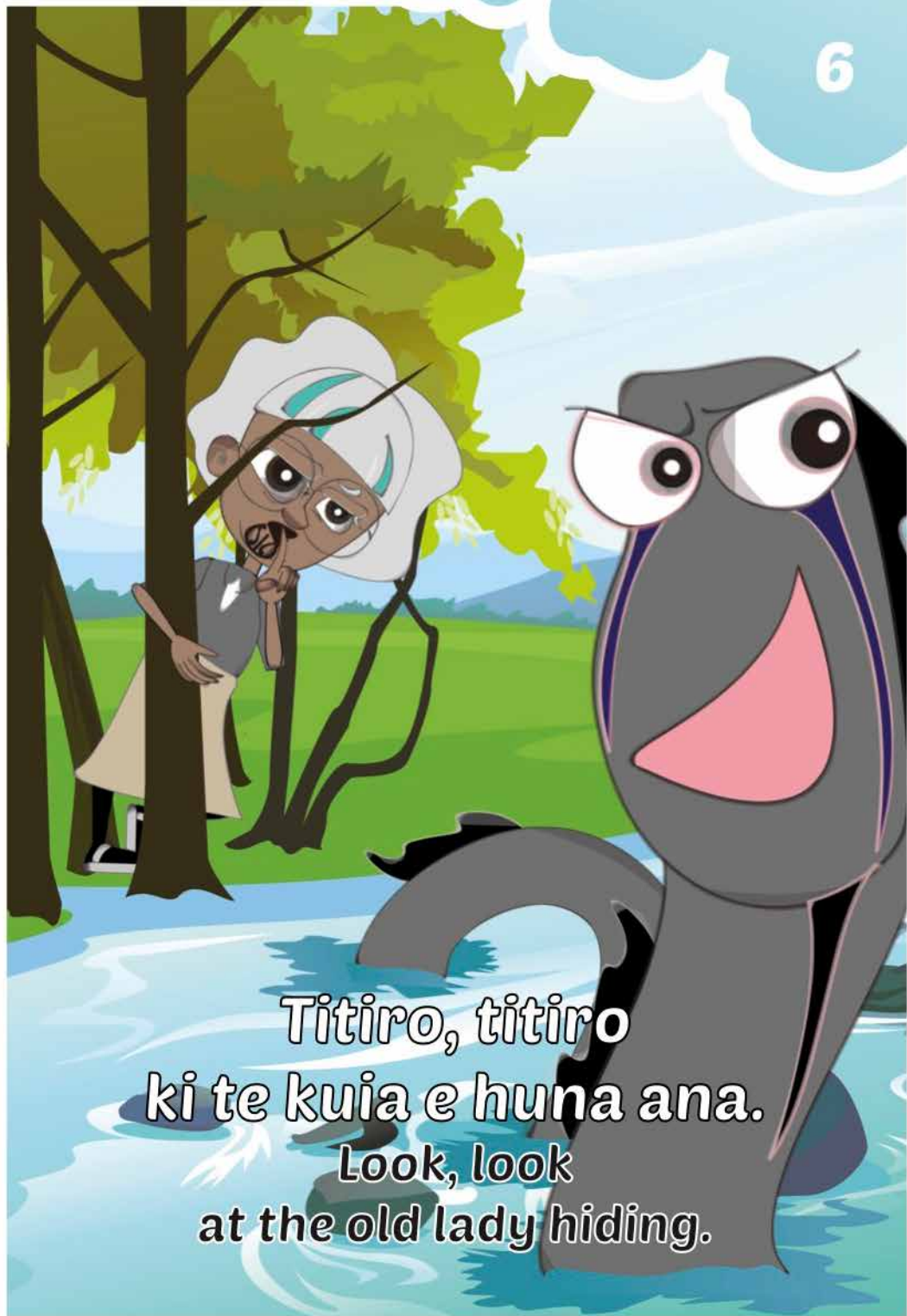

the eel has been caught.**

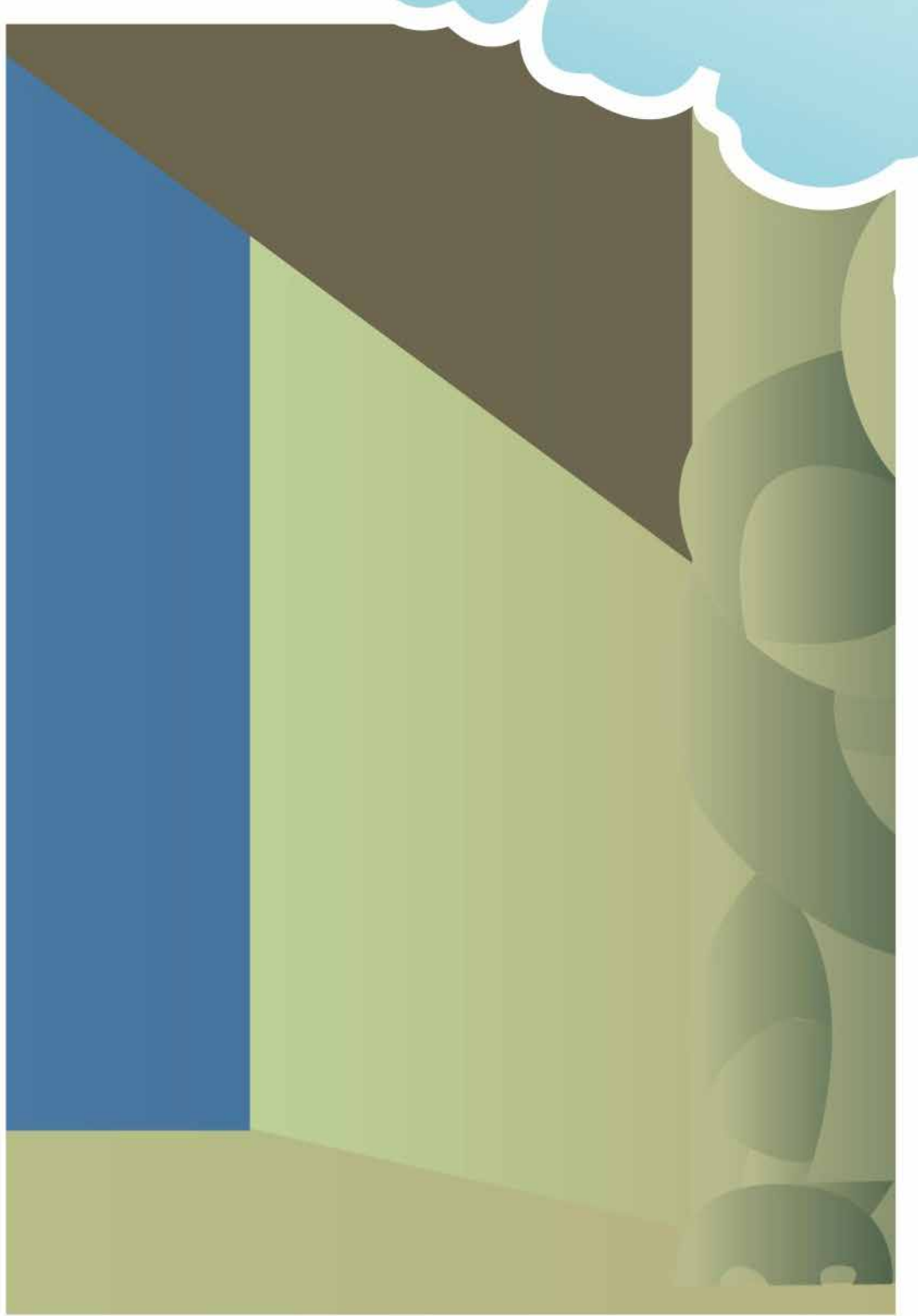
